English: (to be done in your Eng. Language Notebook)

1. Make an attractive dictionary having 10 words of each letter along with their meanings and usage. Paste pictures wherever possible.
2. English Reader – Complete Unit 3
3. Oxford Reading Circle -Read lessons – 7, 8, 9, 10. Underline and write meanings of new words in the lesson itself in the book.

Math : (to be done on A4 size coloured sheets)

1. Make – ‘My Maths Dictionary’
Write minimum three mathematical terms of each alphabet along with meaning / definition.
2. Write birth date / month / year of at least 25 persons (family members / cousins / relatives). Write in Roman Numeral.
3. Revise tables 2 to 20.

Science. : (to be done in your Science Notebook)

1. Form ‘Save Earth Club’ with your neighbourhood friends. The club can perform following activities-
 - a) Plant few trees in your locality and take care of it.
 - b) Keep parks and your locality clean.
 - c) Tell people in your locality how to save water, electricity, etc to save our planet.Write a report on your efforts done in ‘Save Earth Club’ Paste pictures wherever possible.
2. Observe at least 10 different materials which are found around your home. Write their names and classify them into different groups (like opaque, translucent, soluble, insoluble, rough, smooth etc) on the basis of their properties.
3. Live in Style: Think Green! Go Green! Live Green!
Grow your own mini garden! In 3-4 weeks you will have small plants.
 - a) Items you will need: 2 litres plastic soft drink or milk bottle, 1 packet of seeds, 2 cups of soil
 - b) Method: Ask an adult to help you cut the top off the 2 litre plastic bottle. Put the soil in the bottom of your plastic bottle. Next, sprinkle a few seeds on the soil. Water your pot every couple of days. Keep your plant in a safe place and out of the harsh drying sun, in a partly shady location. (Specific date will be given to the students to bring the plant in the school.)

- a) Find out the various public facilities in your area. Paste their pictures. Mention our role and responsibilities towards these public facilities.
- b) Write about any one problem in your locality which you want to improve.

2. Save birds this summer-

Birds need our help way more in the summer months than at any other time during the year. For sparrows, pigeons, parrots and crows feeding stations at house provide a real life line. Lets initiate saving these birds during the heat of the summers by following the steps given below-

- a) Feed the birds with bird seed(bajra)/ cooked vegetable/ grinded cheese but avoid salty food or bread as this can be bad for birds.
- b) Provide them fresh water everyday.
- c) Clean the water feature/ feeder regularly. Rinse and let dry before refilling.
- d) Try to make bird suet/cage and hang it in the shade to attract a varied flock of feathered friends.
- e) Click the pictures and show us what you did. Make a collage and write about your experience of doing this noble deed of helping the bird population this summer.
