1.	English	(To be done in English Language notebook) 1. Project Work – Conducting an Interview Talk to at least two people you admire for their achievements. Also, ask them which quality/qualities were their strengths and helped them in life. Follow the following format to record the information on an A4 size sheet. Science	 Poster Making: Make a poster on A3 size sheet on any one of the given topics: (a) Our Planet, Our Responsibility (b) Reduce, Reuse, Recycle (c) Prominent Scientists and their contribution Classification of plants and animals: (To be done in Science notebook) Collect information and write about any one plant or animal and classify it into different categories like annuals, flowering plants, mesophytes, parasites, seprotrophs, etc.

4.	Social Science	 (To be done in Social Science Map file) 1. Make a project on any five Indian monuments with respect to their names, location and four unique features of each. Paste pictures wherever required. 2. On a political map of Asia, locate and label all the countries of it.

(Paste pictures wherever possible) Examples of selfless acts: Helping with household chores, assisting a classmate with homework, giving a compliment to someone, helping a neighbor with their groceries, picking up litter in your local park.
